

UNAPPROVED MINUTES

WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 28, 2019

Mayor Eder called the meeting to order at 7:12 p.m. at City Hall.

The purpose of the meeting was to work on the 2020 proposed budget.

The 2019 estimated revenues and disbursements were reviewed. At this time, it is unknown if CP Rail will sell the park and parking lot to the city. It's also unknown at this time how much repairs at the swimming pool are going to be. Geislinger would like to seal coat in the Faber Addition, Glenshire Estates and also on 667<sup>th</sup> Avenue (667<sup>th</sup> would be a cost share with Forest Prairie Township) in 2020. There are also pumps that need to be pulled and gone through for both water and sewer in 2020. The proposed disbursements for 2020 for the General Fund are \$658,248. Council will further review the proposed budget at the September 12<sup>th</sup> meeting. The proposed levy and budget must be certified by September 30<sup>th</sup>.
